- Fanny Crosby, a prolific hymn writer, penned the lyrics in 1873
- Though blind, Crosby's spiritual insight led her to compose over 8,000 hymns
- "Blessed Assurance" is one of her most cherished hymns, known for its theme of unwavering faith & spiritual security
- Despite her physical blindness, Crosby lived with a remarkable spiritual clarity

- Her steadfast faith & close relationship with Jesus inspired this hymn, which emphasizes the believer's confidence & assurance in salvation
- Phoebe Knapp, an accomplished musician & friend of Crosby, composed the tune

Blessed assurance, Jesus is mine O what a foretaste of glory divine Heir of salvation, purchase of God I'm born of His Spirit, washed in His blood



The Spirit testifies to our spirit that we are children of God 16 The Spirit himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, (Romans 8:16 ESV)
Jesus calls us to abide in Him, affirming the intimacy of

our relationship

5 I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing. (John 15:5 ESV)

- We can rejoice with assurance, as we await the completion of our salvation
- 8 Though you have not seen him, you love him. Though you do not now see him, you believe in him and rejoice with joy that is inexpressible and filled with glory, 9 obtaining the outcome of your faith, the salvation of your souls. (1 Peter 1:8-9 ESV)

We have an eternal inheritance through Christ

11 In him we have obtained an inheritance, having been predestined according to the purpose of him who works all things according to the counsel of his will, (Ephesians 1:11 ESV)

• Jesus redeems us to be His children, secure in His grace 14 who gave himself for us to redeem us from all lawlessness and to purify for himself a people for his own possession who are zealous for good works. (Titus 2:14 ESV)

Perfect

Believers are to offer themselves wholly to God

1 I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship. 2 Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect. (Romans 12:1-2 ESV)

Perfect

- Jesus' joy fills our lives as we abide in Him
- 11 These things I have spoken to you, that my joy may be in you, and that your joy may be full. (John 15:11 ESV)
- God has prepared unseen blessings for His children

9 But, as it is written, "What no eye has seen, nor ear heard, nor the heart of man imagined, what God has prepared for those who love him" (1 Corinthians 2:9 ESV)

Perfect

• The fullness of joy is found in God's presence

11 You make known to me the path of life; in your presence there is fullness of joy; at your right hand are pleasures forevermore. (Psalm 16:11 ESV)

• The Spirit is our guarantee of eternal life

5 He who has prepared us for this very thing is God, who has given us the Spirit as a guarantee. (2 Corinthians 5:5 ESV)

Perfect submission, all is at rest I in my Savior, I'm happy and blest Watching and waiting, looking above I'm filled with God's goodness, I'm lost in his love



Rest in Jesus

• We find rest in Jesus

28 "Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. 29 Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. 30 For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light." (Matthew 11:28-30 ESV)

Rest in Jesus

In Jesus we find peace

7 And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. (Philippians 4:7 ESV)

- True happiness is for those whose hope is in the Lord
 - 5 Blessed is he whose help is the God of Jacob, whose hope is in the Lord his God, (Psalm 146:5 ESV)

Rest in Jesus

- As His children, we experience God's provision, refreshment & guidance
 - 1 The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want. 2 He makes me lie down in green pastures. He leads me beside still waters. 3 He restores my soul. He leads me in paths of righteousness for his name's sake. (Psalm 23:1-3 ESV)

Practical Applications

- Remind yourself daily of the assurance you have in Christ; let it shape your confidence & joy
- Submit your worries & burdens to Jesus, allowing His peace to fill you
- Embrace each day as an opportunity to experience the "foretaste of glory" promised in salvation
- Reflect on the joy of your salvation & share it with others

Practical Applications

- When challenges arise, turn to Christ's promises for comfort and guidance
- Remind yourself of the eternal life awaiting in Christ, allowing that hope to bring peace
